Canadian Professional Rodeo Association 2017 Gold Card Applications

For members to be eligible for Gold Card status you must be a member in *good standing* who has paid membership dues for a period of *ten (10) consecutive years or over fifteen (15) years* and *be forty-five (45) years of age or over*.

C.P.R.A. Gold Card holders are entitled to enter and compete at all C.P.R.A. rodeos. However, to become eligible to compete, you must *pay the insurance portion* (\$105), the *Sport Medicine* fee (\$25), *Canadian Rodeo News* (\$30) *plus GST* (total \$162.75). These portions of the dues are to be paid annually and are due *prior to two (2) full business days* prior to entries opening. All competing members must *complete the annual renewal forms* before memberships will be processed.

C.P.R.A. Contract Gold Card holders are entitled to work at a C.P.R.A. rodeo. However, to become eligible to work a rodeo, you must *pay the insurance portion* (\$105), the *Sport Medicine* fee (\$25), *Membership Fee* (\$314.00), *Canadian Rodeo News* (\$30) *plus GST* (total \$512.45). These dues are to be paid annually and are due two (2) C.P.R.A. business days prior to working a C.P.R.A. rodeo. All contract members must *complete the annual renewal forms* before memberships will be processed.

C.P.R.A. Gold Card holders that do not compete must complete *the Gold Card application form* before memberships will be processed.
