

PARKING


All contestants will be asked to park in the Lot E of the Coliseum Parking Lot. This lot will be the only lot available with free parking for contests only. All other lots close to the Edmonton EXPO Centre are available for parking but there is a charge or \$15/per vehicle. Please show the parking attendant your CPRA member card for entry and follow the directions of the attendant for parking location.

It is not recommended but, in the event, you must leave you vehicle/trailer in the lot overnight please note that it is not monitored by Security. Please leave at your own risk, and remove all valuables.

Entry to the lot is accessible via the Yellowhead and Wayne Gretzky Drive South, and 75th Street and Wayne Gretzky North and turn at 119th Ave by the 7-11 and Tim Hortons.

Please see the map for access to the Coliseum parking lot in red lines, and horse path movement in blue lines.









HORSE MOVEMENT

As a contestant, you can assist the Explore Edmonton teams by ensuring your horse movement is completed only within the designated route and scheduled periods when moving between the Coliseum Lot E parking Lot to the Hall D Ramp & Warm Up Ring.

To facilitate horse movement to and from the venue, our Parking Attendants and Guest Experience Staff are positioned along the route to ensure the safe delivery and return of you and your horse. Please follow the path outlined in blue on the map. The following windows represent times when horse movement is permitted

- September 23 & 24 evening from 5:30 pm 10:30 pm
- September 24 morning from 9:00 am 1:30 pm

WARM UP RING & ACCESS TO THE HALL D ARENA

There is a warmup ring available for contestants to warm up prior to competition. It is located on the North Plaza of the EXPO Center located beside the Hall D ramp.

If you are using the warmup ring, please be respectful and close the gates behind you. Please do not leave animals unattended.

HALL ACCESS

All contestants will receive an accreditation pass that must be worn when not in competition or for access to the arena floor from the concourse level of Hall D. Accreditation will be distributed upon check with the Rodeo Secretary. Only contestants and rodeo personnel will be authorized to the arena floor.



Access to the Hall D arena by horse will only be permitted via the exterior Hall D ramp. (shown as the blue star on map below). For access to the arena for your event please ensure that you are there and waiting with plenty of time prior to the previous event being completed. There is limited time for change over. Timed event contestants there is also limited space available on the West side of the arena (show as red star below) in the holding area beside the timed event chutes. Please be courteous to other contestants in the area.



CONTESTANT DRESSING ROOMS

Contestant dressing rooms are available on the lower level of the Hall D area, they are located on the East side of the building closest to the Bucking Chute side on either side of the area. There are two sets of stairs located on the North and South sides for access. (shown as yellow star above).
