### **ACCREDITATION**

- CPRA membership cards will be used as your accreditation. You will be required to show your card to gain access to the grounds, the Brandt Centre and lower level of the Brandt Centre. **Please have your membership card available at all times.**

### **ARRIVAL**

- Contestants may arrive after 1:00 PM the day of the performance. Slack contestants may arrive after 6:00 AM Saturday, August 6.

### **PARKING**

- See attached parking map. Parking allowed in designated areas only. Parking passes will be available at the rodeo office upon registration and must be visible in your vehicle at all times. Trucks with trailers attached do not require a pass.
- Vehicles and trailers must leave the grounds following the performance. Overnight parking/camping is not available.
- Due to limited parking Contestants in Slack Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, must leave immediately after to make room for performance contestants.
- Please keep parking area clean. Place all manure, straw and hay in Loraas Bins!


