AGRIBITION – GROUND RULES

C.P.R.A. rule book will be guiding principle rule book. CWA ground rules will supersede C.P.R.A. rules

ACCREDITATION

- CPRA membership cards will be used as your accreditation. You will be required to show your card to gain access to the grounds, the Brandt Centre and lower level of the Brandt Centre. Please have your membership card with you at all times.
- CPRA companion cards will also be required for access to the grounds and Brandt Centre. Companions will be allowed access to the VIP lounge in lower Brandt Centre however not behind the chutes.
- Contestants and companions are not given an assigned seat during the rodeo however may sit in contestant assigned seating highlighted on the Brandt Centre map.

CONTESTANT MEETING

- All contestants will be required to attend a contestants meeting held at 3:30 PM, Wednesday, November 27th in the Cowtown Cowboy Lounge, lower Brandt Centre.
- A Contestant event photo will be taken in the arena at 4:30 PM, Thursday, November 28th in the arena.

MEDIA and PROMOTIONS

- Contestants may be scheduled for volunteer media, sponsor or rodeo opening appearances during your stay. We ask for your cooperation. Round winners must be available for interviews during or after each performance

ACCOMODATIONS

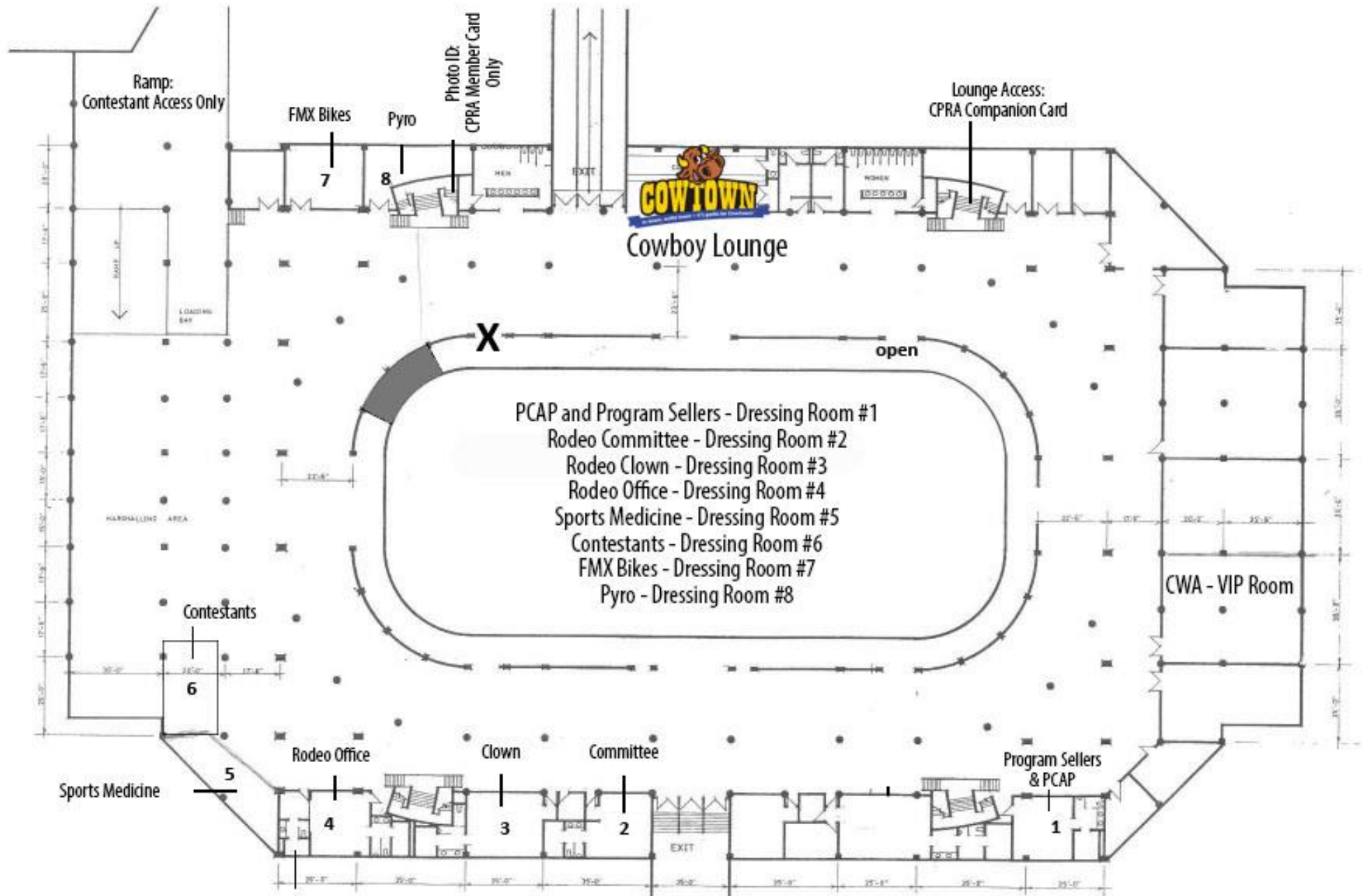
TIMED EVENT CONTESTANTS

- **Only one horse per contestant will be allowed a stall, with the exception of one hazing horse per steer wrestler.**
- Canadian Western Agribition is pleased to announce that timed event contestants will not be required to pay stall fees for 2019 all we ask that you fork/clean your stall out prior to departure. This is our way of saying “thank you”.
- Contestants refer to the enclosed map for arrival plans.
- Horses may arrive between 6:00 PM Tuesday, November 26th – 2:00 PM Wednesday, November 27th.
- Arrival deadline is 2:00 PM Wednesday, November 27th to allow time to take trailers to the off-site trailer parking and return for registration and contestant meeting.
- Horses will be stalled in the Agribition Building and entrance is off the Lewvan Gate. Please refer to the arrival map. Barn Boss (Gary Milton) phone number is on the map. Contact him upon arrival with any questions.
- Tie Down Contestants – Tying of calves on CWA grounds at any time will not be allowed
- Horses are not allowed to be tied or left unattended in the lower Brandt Centre.
- Veterinary Services – Deep South Animal Clinic – 306-924-9754.

ARENA TIME

CWA will make every effort to allow Contestants time in the arena prior to the performances. Once the day's events are complete (approx. 5:00 PM) Contestants may use the arena for ½ hour or until asked to leave. PLEASE be certain to check with the Arena Supervisor (Scott Schweiger) prior to bringing your horse down. Arena time following each performance will be allowed for approximately 1 hour.

- First right to parking lot

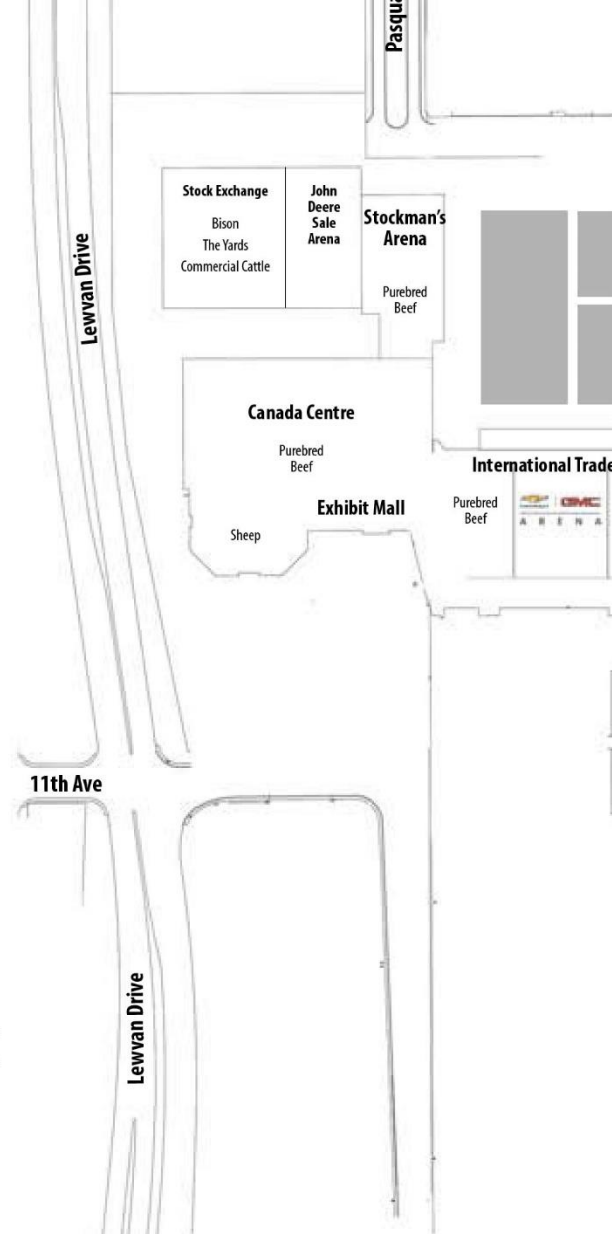
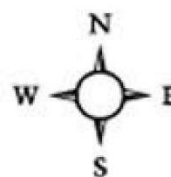
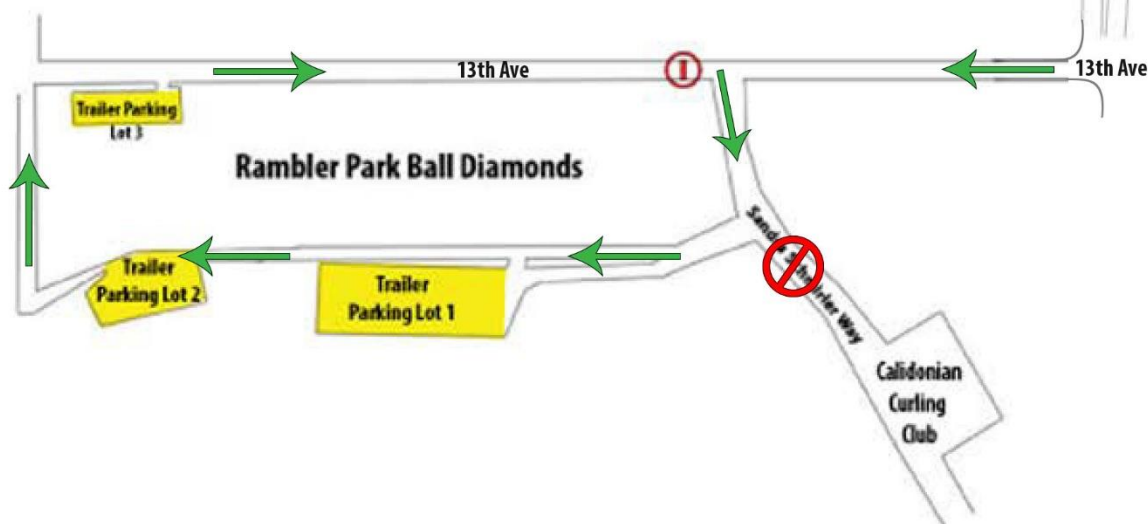

- Tie-outs to be forked for push out by **10:00 am** daily. All manure is hauled and composted. Please take care when pushing your beds that it is free of garbage. Please be sure to pick your tie-outs do not push complete beds.
