

2020 Rule Changes

Section I F. 4. All existing Association stock contractors must be the stock contractor listed first (1st) on two (2) Association approved rodeos each rodeo season to take stock to the CFR.

Section I G. Rodeo Committee

Only one membership shall be issued to a Rodeo Committee for each rodeo that is approved. A separate membership fee is required for each rodeo approval granted.

The membership fee will be deducted from the approval fee paid by the Rodeo Committee and is non-refundable should a rodeo cancel after it has been approved.

Membership fees for each Rodeo Committee are based on the total purse for CPRA events, in accordance with the following scale:

Committee purse.....	Dues
\$0 to \$4,099	\$500
\$4,100 to \$7,999	\$750
\$8,000 and above	\$1000

Section III B. 4. b. All new rodeos will be approved at the discretion of the Association Board of Directors

Section III 4. B. c. Special events must have a minimum of ten thousand (\$10,000) added in each event. All special events, regardless of format, are subject to approval by the Association board. Inclusion of optional events is subject to approval by the Association board.

Section VI B. 8. a. The number of tie down and team roping cattle to produce a one head Association approved rodeo will be no more, no less than half enough (1/2) plus two (2) or one for everyone plus two (2). Steer wrestling will be half enough (1/2) or one for everyone.

- i. In the tie down roping committees have the option of supplying one third (1/3) plus two (2) the amount of cattle as contestants, up to, and including the May long weekend, at the discretion of the event representative.
- ii. In the steer wrestling committees have the option of supplying one third (1/3) or 1/3 enough plus two (2) the amount of cattle as contestants at the discretion of event representative.

Section X I. 2. Bucking stock must be in an approved CPRA draw three (3) times to qualify to be eligible to compete at the CFR. Animals turned out will count as a trip.

ADD- Section X Season Leader Eligibility

To be eligible for season leader awards recipients must have competed at fifteen (15) regular season CPRA rodeos during the current season.

- a. Ladies Barrel Racers must have competed at no less than eighteen (18) regular season CPRA rodeos during the current season.
- b. Special events/contests shall not be applied to the rodeo count.
- c. Canadian Rodeo Tour Finals shall be applied to the rodeo count.
- d. There is no minimum requirement for number of rodeos to qualify for season leaders in the optional events.
